Dubai Electricity and Water Authority (Dewa) on Monday said around 58.48 percent of work on its Dh1.42 billion pumped-storage hydroelectric power plant beingbuiltinHattahasbeencompleted.The power plant will have a production capacity of 250 megawatts (MW), a storagecapacity of 1,500 megawatt-hours and a life span of up to 80 years. This is the firststation of its kind in the GCC and is planned for completion in Q4 of 2024.
